Dear EAGLE Parents and Guardians,

EAGLE College Prep schools value the health and well-being of our scholars. Thank you for allowing us the time to gather the facts on the recent COVID-19 (Coronavirus). We wanted to provide an update to the fast moving COVID-19 (Coronavirus) that is being reported in the local and national news. **Based on information gathered, we have decided that EAGLE schools will remain open until further notice.** We hope this note will provide some additional information on steps we're taking on a school level. The St. Louis Department of Health officials assure us that the risk in our community is currently low.

This is a good time to review preventative measures we can all take to stop the spread of respiratory viruses. It is recommended that you conduct frequent hand washing, avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home when you are sick. A reminder that students with a fever should stay home until they are fever-free for 24- hours without taking any fever reducing medications. Students also need to be free of respiratory symptoms.

Know that our EAGLE schools are taking precautions inside of our classrooms for your children, such as disinfecting of learning, eating and play spaces, as well as encouraging our staff to take proper preventative measures.

We have decided to hold parent teacher conferences over the phone to ensure a healthy learning environment. We will be sharing steps on how this will take place shortly.

We will keep you updated with any developments that could impact our families or schools. Updates will be sent to you using Infinite Campus. As always, if you change your email address or contact information, please be sure to notify your child's school office of the change to ensure that you can stay informed. We will continue to remain in close contact with St. Louis city and state health officials regarding the spread of COVID-19 and we will keep you updated with any developments that could impact our community or schools.
