## Parent/Guardian Guide to Assessments at EAGLE College Prep

---

### NWEA Grades K-8

The NWEA assessment is a growth measurement tool that we use to accurately measure a student's performance. The information that we get from this assessment allows us to pinpoint the instructional areas your student is ready to tackle- whether they are on, above or below grade level.

### STEP Assessment

STEP is an acronym that stands for the Strategic Teaching and Evaluation of Progress. It is a reading assessment that we use to gauge our students' reading levels and an assessment that provides us with data to further tailor our instruction to meet their needs. The STEP assessment is administered 4 times per school year.

### Interim Assessments (IA) Grades K-8

The interim assessments are a tool that we use as an organization to reflect on curriculum trends and what adjustments we may need to make instructionally. This assessment also tests scholars on 30% of information that they should know by the end of the year to see if they can use what they already know.

### Missouri Assessment Program (MAP)

The Missouri MAP assessment, otherwise known as the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP), is designed to measure how well students are acquiring the skills and knowledge described in Missouri's Learning Standards. Students in grades 3-8 are given this assessment once a year in the spring.
